#### Objectives and Investment Policy

The investment objective of the Fund is to provide sterling capital and income growth over the long-term. The Fund's income target is 120% in excess of the income on the FTSE All Share Index. The Fund may invest in transferable securities, money market investments, deposits, units in collective investment schemes and forward transactions.

The Fund will seek to achieve its investment objective by investing in a globally diversified portfolio selected from equities, bonds, collective investment schemes, cash, money market instruments, deposits and forward transactions.

The Fund appoints one or more Investment Manager(s) to achieve its objective. Allocations to Investment Managers are subject to change in order to meet the Fund's objective and further details regarding the allocations are available upon request from the Manager.

The Fund uses the Investment Association Global Equity Income UK Equity and Bond Income peer group for performance comparison purposes. The peer group has been selected as a comparator for performance because the constituents are closely aligned with the parameters set out in the policy of the Fund, and it is therefore an appropriate comparator for the Fund's performance

The base currency of the Fund is pounds sterling.

Income arising from the Fund is distributed to the holders of income units, and reinvested in the case of accumulation units. Investors can buy and sell units on demand when the scheme prices daily at 10am.

#### **Risk and Reward Profile**



The risk rating of the Fund is category 4 due to the volatility of the Fund price which sits in a range of between 5% and 10%. The risk rating is calculated using historical data and a prescribed standard deviation methodology.


