## **Objectives and Investment Policy**

The investment objective of the Fund is to maximise total return through a combination of growth and income.

The Fund invests in a diversified global portfolio. The Fund will have exposure of no less than 30% in equity markets and 30% in fixed income assets, typically indirectly through the use of collective investment schemes, although direct investments may be made. The Fund may also invest, directly or indirectly (through the use of collective investment schemes) in warrants, money market instruments, deposits, cash and near cash.

The use of derivatives and/or hedging transactions is permitted in connection with the Efficient Portfolio Management of the Fund. It is not intended that the use of derivatives for this purpose will be frequent.

The base currency of the Fund is pounds sterling.

Income arising from the Fund is distributed to the holders of income shares, and reinvested in the case of accumulation shares. Investors can buy and sell shares on demand when the scheme prices daily at 12 midday.


