Objectives and Investment Policy

The Fund aims to achieve positive returns (with a combination of income and growth of capital) with a target return in excess of the UK Retail Prices Index (the RPI), net of fees, with lower volatility than the Morningstar UK NR GBP Index, on average, over a five year rolling period. There is no guarantee that this return will be achieved over a rolling 5 year period, or any other period and capital is at risk. The Investment Manager adopts a flexible investment strategy and may invest in some or all sectors and in some or all world markets (including the UK), in order to best take advantage of economic opportunities worldwide. The assets in which the Fund will invest will be equities, fixed income investments (for example, corporate and government bonds) and other transferable securities. The Fund may also invest in Exchange Traded Notes and Exchange Traded Commodities, money market instruments, deposits, cash and near cash investments and alternatives (for example, gold and commodities). The composition of the Scheme Property as between equities, fixed income and other assets, will vary over time in response to the Investment Manager's views of the economic and market environment. The above exposure may be gained directly or through the use of collective

investment vehicles (including exchange traded vehicles and investment trusts) which may include collective investment vehicles managed by the Manager or its associates or the Investment Manager or its associates. The Fund will only hold alternatives indirectly via permitted instruments such as collective investment vehicles. Typically regulated collective investment vehicles will be used but unregulated collective investment vehicles may also be used in accordance with the FCA Rules. Derivatives will only be used for efficient portfolio management (including hedging). The Investment Manager will actively manage the Fund. This means the Investment Manager actively makes decisions about how to invest the Scheme Property (and which investments to buy and sell) instead of simply following a market index.

The base currency of the Fund is pounds sterling.

Income arising from the Fund is distributed to the holders of income units, and reinvested in the case of accumulation units. Investors can buy and sell units on demand when the scheme prices daily at 12 midday.

Risk and Reward Profile



The risk rating of the Fund is category 4 due to the volatility of the Fund price which sits in a range of between 5% and 10%. The risk rating is calculated using historical data and a prescribed standard deviation methodology.
